WHAT ARE THE RISKS? Twitter is a social media network which allows users to post short messages (tweets) of up to 280 characters. Tweets can consist of text, photos, videos, audio, links, polls and GIFs — often linked by hashtags if they chare a common theme or message. Hashtags receiving high levels of interest are said to be trending.
