

ATTENDANCE What do the new rules

mean for me?

With effect from the 19 August 2024, the law changes and Penalty Notices have increased.

Holidays in Term Time


I want to go on holiday for a week during the school term.



Your holiday will not be authorised, unless there are exceptional circumstances. You should speak to the school before booking anything. When your child misses 5 school days you will be issued with a fixed penalty fine. Penalty charges will be £160 if paid within 28 days reducing to £80 if paid within 21 days per parent/carer per child.

For every child in the family (of compulsory school age) a fine will be issued.







£160 + £160 for each parent = £640

Second Holiday Absence

If in any period of less than 3 years, your child has a 3 second leave of absence further sanctions will be issued.



one child £320 two children f640 three children £960 for each parent



There is no discount for early payment.

Third Holiday Absence



If in any period of less than 3 years, your child has a third leave of absence further sanctions will be issued.



£2.500



A penalty notice fine will **not** be given, Instead the case will be taken to court. A magistrate is able to fine each parent £2500 for each child.

Irregular Attendance

If your child is absent for 10 or more sessions in a 10 week period, and the absence is unauthorised the school will consider prosecution by an education penalty notice.
